## Have you seen a singing *female* Oriental Magpie-Robin (*Copsychus saularis*)?

- Researchers want to study differences in male and female Oriental Magpie-robin songs throughout their range.
- However, female songs are not well documented.
- We are seeking recordings of their songs, especially from Southeast and Pacific Asia.

If you see a singing female (or male) Magpie-robin, please record their songs and upload them through <u>eBird</u> or <u>xeno-canto</u>.



Females are distinguished from pure black and white males by their grey heads and buffy sides.

Add the phrase "*Contributed for the female bird song project: femalebirdsong.org*" to your notes, so we can find your recording.

If you record a female and singing males are nearby, record some males, too. Recordings of males and females from the same location are especially useful!
